## Application Criteria

### Uddingston Hockey Club Modern Apprentice

- The yearlong contract is envisaged to run August 17 to August 18 with dates being flexible.
- The contract duration is 52 week and is not flexible.
- Candidates must have left school and not be in full time employment.
- All candidates have to be U25 on the day they start their MA with the Sports Academy of Scotland.
- Candidates will be contracted and salaried with UHC for 12 months and paid on 28<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- A working week of at least around 35 hrs of timetabled coaching activity will be required.
- Activities will include day time in-school programme, evening and weekend club programme.
- Candidate will work towards the SVQ L3 in Leisure Management with the Sports Academy of Scotland.
- Candidate must have ability to complete a coaching/UKCC L1 and or L2.
- Sports Academy of Scotland will deliver and certificate the SVQ on behalf of UHC and candidate.
- Candidates should be computer literate and have regular access to a computer for on-line portfolio.
- Candidates will need to currently hold or have the ability to achieve all 5 SQA Core Skills at (SCQF L5) Intermediate 2 delivered and assessed by the Sports Academy of Scotland.
